### **3. Competition Rules and Regulations**

#### **3.1 Competition Rules**

The shooting events and competition of the 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Games Singapore 2009 will be carried out in accordance with the current International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) Rules and Regulations.

In the case of disagreement over the interpretation of the Rules, the English Text shall prevail. Any unforeseen incidents not covered by the Rules shall be resolved in accordance with the OCA Constitution and Rules and the ISSF and Asian Shooting Confederation (ASC) Rules.

#### **3.2 Meetings and Briefings**

Meetings and briefings will be arranged at a place and time to be confirmed.

#### **3.3 Protests and Appeals**

Protests and appeals shall be dealt with according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

The official form of appeals must be accompanied by a fee as described in the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

#### **3.4 Sports Entries**

##### **Preliminary Entry (Entry by Number)**

Each participating OCA member (NOCs) must submit preliminary entry forms (Entry by Number) to SAYGOC by 2400hrs (GMT +8, Singapore local time) on 15 January 2009. This form may be submitted by fax but the original form must be returned no later than 15 Jan 2009. SAYGOC's address, telephone, fax and email address can be found on the entry form.

## Final Entry (Entry by Name)

Each participating OCA member (NOCs) must send the final entry form (Entry by Name) to SAYGOC by 2400hrs (GMT +8, Singapore local time) on 30 April 2009. Any late forms, additional applications, or other alterations shall not be accepted after this time. SAYGOC's address, telephone, fax and email address can be found on the entry form.

### 3.5 Participants

Only competitors who comply with the Constitution and Rules of OCA and ISSF are entitled to take part in the 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Games Singapore 2009 shooting competition.

All competitors must be between the ages of 14 and 17 years old (born in the year 1992 to 1995).

NOCs to ensure that competitor's entry by name submission must only be for one sport. That is, each competitor is allowed to register and be accredited to participate in one sport only, as per guidelines specified in the Entries and Accreditation Manual.

According to the General regulations of the ISSF, each NOC member may enter the maximum number of shooters in each event as follows:

<b>JUNIOR MEN</b>		
10m Air Rifle	60 shot	2
10m Air Pistol	60 shot	2

<b>JUNIOR WOMEN</b>		
10m Air Rifle	40 shot	2
10m Air Pistol	40 shot	2

### **3.6 Doping Control / Gender Verification**

Doping control during the 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Youth Games Singapore 2009 will be conducted in accordance with OCA Anti-Doping Rules applicable to the Asian Youth Games and will follow the standards under the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

### **3.7 Gender Verification**

Gender verification tests may be carried out in accordance with the OCA Constitution and Rules, except for those competitors who present a valid certificate of femininity issued by the IOC Medical Commission or the OCA Sports Medical Commission.

### **3.8 Equipment**

Equipment and facilities will follow in accordance with the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

### **3.9 Dress Code**

All competitors participating in the shooting competition must wear appropriate clothing and apparel that complies with the ISSF Rules and Regulations.

### **3.10 Victory Ceremonies**

Preparation for the victory ceremony will commence soon after the final results are announced. The ceremony will take place in front of the VIP stands. Medals and mascot bearers will enter the field of play and take their position. Competitors will be escorted to the podium. The medals will be presented by the OCA President or his representative. The National Anthem of the gold medal winner(s) will be played and the flags of the winners will be hoisted. Winners must wear their NOC official sports uniform.

### 3.11 Media Interviews

Competitors should go through the mixed zone after their event whenever there is a mixed zone set up. Competitors should attend press conferences / interviews when requested.
