TECHNICAL INFORMATION BULLETIN

This Bulletin is published to update all ASC member Federations concerning the technical build-up for the Games. It contains some important information received from the Guangzhou Asian Games Organising Committee (GAGOC).

ASC under the leadership of the President, H.E. Sheikh Salman S. S. H. Al-Sabah, has been working to obtain necessary information from GAGOC and the ASC Technical Delegates have been also working tirelessly with GAGOC to ensure the facilities and arrangements are in accordance with both ASC and ISSF conditions for international championships.

The latest programmes showing provisional training times are attached. More details should become available following confirmation of the Final Entries that were due on the 30th September 2010.

Unofficial Training

Rifle and Pistol – Aoti Shooting Range

November 8th to 11th. Daily timing: 09:00 – 11:00; 14:00 – 16:00.

Note there will be NO training possible from the 5th to 7th November inclusive.

Shotgun – Guangzhou Shotgun Centre

November 5th to 16th. Daily timing: 09:00 – 15:00.

Depending on the final programme and entry numbers, there may also be limited unofficial training for DT and Skeet once the Trap competitions have started.

No ammunition for the Centre Fire Pistol men competition is available. Competitors should bring their own centre-fire pistol ammunition.

Shotgun

B & P F2 Match Olympic Edition 24gr – sizes # 7 and # 9

The price for one box (25) is 150 RMB (CNY).

The Organisers stress that supplies of shotgun ammunition are limited and competitors are advised to bring all necessary ammunition. No other brands are available.

Federations are therefore advised to consult the GAGOC manual "Guidelines for the Management of Sporting Guns and Ammunition in the Shooting Events" that has been sent to all Federations.

In all cases Federations and shooters are advised to take their own ammunition because GAGOC confirm that supplies of all ammunition in Guangzhou are limited and for 'back-up usage' only.

Training Rounds

Shotgun – the training fee for Skeet and Trap is 7 EUR/round (25 targets) and for Double Trap is 14 EUR/round (50 targets).

Ranges

All Pistol, Rifle and Running Target ranges are equipped with Sius Ascor targets.

There are # 5 shotgun combined ranges equipped with Mattarelli target machines and 'Multi-Pull' acoustics (Elettronica Progetti).

Local Accommodation (Shotgun Ranges)

Due to the long distance and travel time (estimated 1.5/2 hours at peak times) from the Games Village, GAGOC will provide hotel accommodation nearby the venue for PET and competition days for all shotgun athletes in twin bed rooms.
