Japan Clay Target Shooting Association as the Organizing Committee has the pleasure to host 2009 Asian Clay Shooting Championship in Kumamoto Prefecture, Japan and cordially invite all members of the Asian Shooting Confederation and Asian Clay Shooting Association to participate to the games held during 20th to 27th August, 2009.

1. COMPETITION PROGRAM:

2. COMPETITION INFORMATION:

1. Men	Trap	125/25 targets for qualified/final
2. Women	Trap	75/25 targets for qualified/final
3. Men	Double Trap	150/50 targets for qualified/final
4. Men	Skeet	125/25 targets for qualified/final
5. Women	Skeet	75/25 targets for qualified/final

Maximum number of entries in each event is 5 shooters per nation (3 for team and 2 for MQS).

Remarks:

On this occasion of 2009 Asian Clay Shooting Championship in Kumamoto Japan, we plan to organize both 2009 Asian Friendship Shooting Competition and Juniors Competition.

As to 2009 Asian Friendship Shooting Competition, entries are open for any members of the participating country. However, it is to be noted that number of participants shall be adjusted by the Organizing Committee in

case of the excessive entries to the event due to the limitation of ranges.

3. COMPETITION RULES:

All competitions shall be conducted as per Rules and Regulations set by ISSF.

4. DOPING CONTROL:

The Organizing Committee will conduct doping control according to ISSF Doping Control regulations.

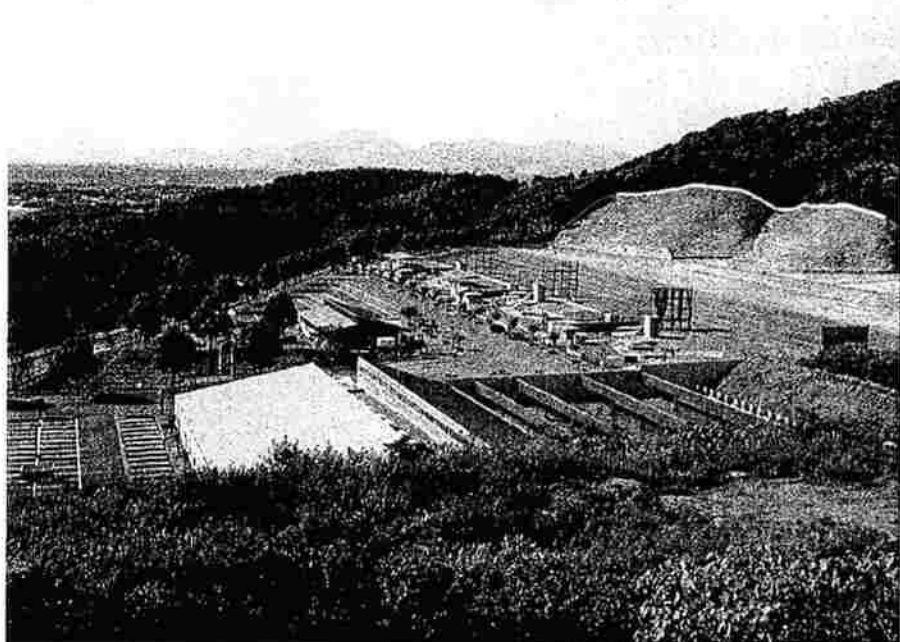
5. ISSF IDENTIFICATION (ID) NUMBER:

All competitors to 2009 Asian Clay Shooting Championship must have an ISSF Identification Number.

6. THE SHOOTING RANGE:

The competition will take place at Kumamoto Sogo Shooting Range which is equipped with 4 shooting fields, consisting of 1 Trap, 1 Skeet and 2 Trap/Skeet combined. All fields are facing to the north.

The Shooting Range is familiar to many international shooters through hosting the ISSF World Cup in 1999 very successfully and also other grand-prix competitions, and it is classified as "AAA" as per our inter-association (JCTSA) standard.

8. ENTRY PROCEDURE & WEAPONS PERMIT:

Both Entry and Customs Declarations are to be made only at Fukuoka

International Airport due to the restriction and control of Weapons brought into Japan. Therefore all foreign participants are kindly reminded to make their entries only at Fukuoka International Airport.

Upon arrival of the participating team, the police department will issue Temporary Weapons Permit to all participants for the competition purpose. The copy of the Form (Annex 4) will be used to obtain the Temporary Weapons Permit from the police department. This permit should be returned to the police officer at Fukuoka airport through departure procedure.

9. TRANSPORTATION:

The entry airport to Japan is limited to Fukuoka International Airport. The Organization Committee will provide transportation service between Fukuoka International Airport, the Official Hotels and Shooting Range. The transportation from the airport to the official hotels will be on bus which takes 1 and half hours (90 minutes). All participants not residing at official hotels shall be responsible of their own transportation.

11. CLAY & MACHINE:

NASTA brand targets are to be used in the games for both qualified/final.

NASTA target ejection machines are to be used.

Electronic Scoreboard is readily available on each site.

12. AMMUNITIONS:

Please note that no ammunition is allowed to be brought into Japan by the participants. Ammunitions such as Winchester, Remington and Apollo (Japanese) are available at ¥1,000 or US\$10 per 25 bullets at the Shooting Range.

13. STORAGE OF WEAPONS AND AMMUNITIONS:

Storage of weapons and ammunitions is available at the Shooting Range.

During the competition, all weapons and ammunitions of the participants should be stored in the storage.

Weapons and ammunitions are not allowed to be brought into hotels.

14. ENTRY FEES & PAYMENT:

Preliminary Entry Form: See Annex 2, 3 & 5.

Entry fees: for shooters ¥15,000 or US\$150

for officials ¥5,000 or US \$50

Training Fee: Trap & Skeet ¥1,000 or US\$10 per round

Double Trap ¥2,000 or US\$20 per round

Entry procedure as well as all payments of Entry Fees, Hotel Accommodation and Training Fees should be made at the Shooting Range.

Please note that the payment shall be made either in Japanese Yen (¥) or US Dollars. Any payment by credit cards or personal checks is not acceptable.

15. CEREMONIES

The Opening Ceremony will be held at 18:00 of 21st August, 2009 at Hotel Nikko, Kumamoto.

The Closing Ceremony will be held on 26th August, 2009 at the Shooting Range after the Award Ceremony of Men's Skeet Final.

Participating countries are requested to bring their National Flag and a tape or CD for the National Anthem.

16. WEATHER

The weather in Kumamoto in the late August is extremely HOT. The average daytime temperature will be 28 - 32 °C. After dark, it will be 15 -20 °C.

17. SIGHT-SEEING
