2. Venue

The Championship will take place at Gongxi Shooting Complex in Taoyuan City.

The ranges will be equipped with SIUS ASCOR electronic targets as follows:

10M Range: 60 firing lines

Final Hall: 10 firing lines

3. Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted according to the ASC General Regulations and ISSF Rules and Regulations Edition 2017 (second print V1.1, 01/2018).

Jury members (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be nominated by ASC to supervise the Asian Championship.

The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF rules using approved instruments.

4. Participation

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must register officially from his Federation.

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual and team event and up to two (2) additional athletes for MQS.

All athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All shooters included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions.

Late 'issue' of an ISSF ID number will be considered as a 'late entry' under ISSF Rules.

5. Shooting Events

Enclosed you will find a detailed Preliminary Competition Program.

5-1-Senior:

5-4.The team and individual competitions will be held if at least the team and individual comprises are as follows:

- a. Men: 15 Individual and 5 teams
- b. Women: 10 Individual and 4 team
- c. Men and Women Junior 10 Individual and 3 teams

6. Protests

Any protest on the result of any competition must be submitted a maximum 10 minutes after the announcement of the official results (Rule 6.16.4).

The protest fee is € 50 and appeal fee is € 100 -U.S Dollar equivalent is acceptable. The payment will be refunded, only if the protest is accepted. Protests and appeals should be in writing, using ISSF Protest Forms (available from the Organizers).

7. Late Entries

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules. (Rule: 3.7.3).

Any Federation reducing the number of shooters / or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organizing Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no shooter of that Federation may participate in the Championship. The Deadlines are as follows:

- a. Final Entry Deadline - 23 February 2019

b. Late Entry Deadline - 21 March 2019

c. From 22 March 2019 onwards, no additional entries can be accepted

8. Entry Process

Each ASC Federation entering the competition must submit the necessary forms (Annexes 1-9) and submit them before the following deadlines. All forms are available on the ISSF online Registration (<http://entry.issf-sports.info>) and ASC websites.

- Entry must be made by appropriate forms or by online ISSF registration system.
- Any entry accepted after the final entry deadline will incur a penalty of USD 50 per start, to be paid to the Organizing Committee by the defaulter Federation.

9. Firearms and Ammunition

The firearms control act is very strict in Chinese Taipei. All teams carrying firearms which will enter and depart customs have to send back the fully completed firearms and ammunition form (Annex 8) before the deadline of 23rd February. This association will send a staff bringing with the document of approved application to the airport to assist the teams in customs clearance. After leaving the airport, the firearms and ammunition must be stored in the armory at the shooting range, and it is absolutely prohibited to take them out from the shooting range or bring them to the hotel.

10. Ceremonies

Opening Ceremony will take place at the Caesar Metro Taipei at 6:30pm on March 26th 2019.

Award Ceremonies will take place daily as indicated in the provisional program. All teams must bring their national anthem (MP3) and two national flags (1 x 2 m) and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the accreditation process.

11. Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will be held at the final hall at 11a.m. March 26th 2019.

12. Fees

14. Transportation/Airport

The Organizing Committee will provide the transport service for all the delegations between the Taoyuan International Airport (TPE), and the official hotels during the official days of the 12th Asian Airgun Championships 2019. Participating federations will be met and facilitated on arrival at the airport. Teams will then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the Gongxi Shooting Range to deposit their firearms and ammunition and then taken to the official hotel. The transportation from airport (pick-up/drop-off) to the official hotel is free of charge during the period between the official arrival and departure day. For the persons who wish to arrive earlier or leave later, the cost of the transportation for airport pick-up/drop-off will be **USD 50.00** per person.

The Organizing Committee will also provide local transportation on the daily basis between the official hotels and the shooting range, according to the official transport schedule.

Delegations staying in the unofficial hotels will be responsible for their own transportation.

Participating Federations should confirm their departure time with the Organizers at least 48 hours prior to departure.

15. Doping control

Doping Control will operate in accordance with WADA/ISSF/ASC Rules and Regulations.

16. Weather

Temperatures during the period range from 15°C to 22°C. Average sun light is 12 hours/day. Average humidity is about 75%.

17. Visas

Participants who need entry visa assistance, please fill out the Visa Support Form attached with passport copy and send them via email to the Organizing Committee not later than 23rd February 2019. For Entry Visas information, please refer to the website <https://www.boca.gov.tw/mp-2.html>

18. Registration and Payments

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries and accommodation fees MUST be made to the Organizing Committee at the Registration Office at the shooting complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after all accounts have been fully paid and receipted by the Organizers.

19. Internet facilities

Wireless internet access is available at the shooting range.

20. Media Relations

On site media facilities will be available for accredited media personnel.

21. First AID

During the competition, the Organizers will provide first aid.
