2. Venue

The Championship will take place at SHOOTING PLAZA Complex in Shymkent City.

The ranges will be equipped with SIUS ASCOR electronic targets as follows:

10M Range: 50 firing lines

Final Hall: 10 firing lines

10m RT: 3 firing lines

3. Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted according to the ASC General Regulations and ISSF Rules and Regulations Edition.

Jury members (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, RTS Jury and Equipment Control Jury) will be nominated by ASC to supervise the Asian Championship.

The equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF rules using approved instruments.

4. Participation

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must register officially from his Federation.

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per individual and team event and up to two (2) additional athletes for MQS.

All athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All shooters included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions. Late 'issue' of an ISSF ID number will be considered as a 'late entry' under ISSF Rules.

5-4-Mixed Team: ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman.

5-5.The teams competitions will be held if at least the team comprises are as follows:

a. Men:	3 teams
b. Women:	3 teams
c. Men and Women Junior	3 teams

Juniors may participate in one (1) category only-either in the junior's or in the senior's events.

Youth may participate only Youth Category and Entry process of Youth participants must submit directly to OC.

Since the Youth Olympic Games in Dakar have been postponed to 2026, there will be no quota places allocation at the 14th Asian Airgun Championship in Kazakhstan 2021.

6. **Protests**

Any protest on the result of any competition must be submitted a maximum 10 minutes after the announcement of the official results (Rule 6.16.4).

The protest fee is € 50 and appeal fee is € 100 -U.S Dollar equivalent is acceptable. The payment will be refunded, only if the protest is accepted. Protests and appeals should be in writing, using ISSF Protest Forms (available from the Organizers).

7. **Late Entries**

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules. (Rule: 3.7.3).

Any Federation reducing the number of shooters / or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organizing Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no shooter of that Federation may participate in the Championship. The Deadlines are as follows:

- a. Final Entry Deadline - 10 August 2021
- b. Late Entry Deadline - 6 September 2021
- c. From 7 September 2021 onwards, no additional entries can be accepted

8. **Entry Process**

Each ASC Federation entering the competition must submit the necessary forms (Annexes 1-9) and submit them before the following deadlines. All forms are available on the ISSF online Registration (<http://entry.issf-sports.info>) and ASC websites.

- Entry must be made by appropriate forms or by online ISSF registration system.
- Any entry accepted after the final entry deadline will incur a penalty of USD 50 per start, to be paid to the Organizing Committee by the defaulter Federation.

9. **Firearms and Ammunition**

All athletes must declare the firearms and ammunition to be brought into Kazakhstan and return to the Organizing Committee the Firearm and

Ammunition Form (Annex 8) no later than **10 AUG 2021**. Please submit the form fully completed, signed and stamped by the federation.

Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned, unprocessed.

All participating federations are advised to book their flight directly to Shymkent International Airport, Almaty International Airport and Nursultan Nazarbayev International Airport.

Reception and clearance of guns and ammunition will **ONLY** be arranged at the Shymkent International Airport, Almaty International Airport and Nursultan Nazarbayev International Airport.

The cost of the Gun Permit Fee is USD 70.00 per permit.

10. Ceremonies

There will be no Opening or Closing Ceremony.

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range / Finals hall immediately after the end of each Final.

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms). All teams must bring their national anthem (MP3) and two national flags (1 x 2 m) and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the accreditation process.

11. Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will be held at the final hall at 11a.m. September 11th 2021.

14. Transportation/Airport

The Organizing Committee will provide the transport service for all the delegations between the Shymkent International Airport, and the official hotels during the official days of the 14th Asian Airgun Championships 2021. Participating federations will be met and facilitated on arrival at the airport. Teams will then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the SHOOTING PLAZA Range to deposit their firearms and ammunition and then taken to the official hotel. The transportation from airport (pick-up/drop-off) to the official hotel is free of charge during the period between the official arrival and

departure day. For the persons who wish to arrive earlier or leave later, the cost of the transportation for airport pick-up/drop-off will be **USD 50.00** per person.

The Organizing Committee will also provide local transportation on the daily basis between the official hotels and the shooting range, according to the official transport schedule.

Delegations staying in the unofficial hotels will be responsible for their own transportation.

Participating Federations should confirm their departure time with the Organizers at least 48 hours prior to departure.

15. Doping control

Doping Control will operate in accordance with WADA/ISSF/ASC Rules and Regulations.

16. Weather

Temperatures during the period range from 15°C to 28°C. Average humidity is about 37%.

17. Visas

VISA Support Form (Annex 7) will be provided by the Organizing Committee for the Championship. Participants who need VISA support letter are kindly requested to complete VISA Support Form and return it to the Organizing Committee not later than **27 July 2021** (In connection with the COVID-19 pandemic, additional approvals are required with the authorized Ministries of the Republic of Kazakhstan). Please submit the form fully completed. The Form must be sent in WORD format.

Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be Returned, unprocessed.

At a border checkpoint any foreigner above the age of 16, receives migration card, which is returned while exiting from Kazakhstan.

18. Registration and Payments

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries and accommodation fees MUST be made to the Organizing Committee at the Registration Office at the shooting complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after all accounts have been fully paid and receipted by the Organizers.

19. Internet facilities

Wireless internet access is available at the shooting range.

20. Media Relations

On site media facilities will be available for accredited media personnel.

21. First AID

During the competition, the Organizers will provide first aid.

22. Temporary Regulations For Testing And Health Monitoring Methods For Covid-19

For participating delegations:

- all members of the delegation must take a PCR test 72 hours before departure from their country;
- the delegation must have an adequate supply of masks and gloves and hand sanitizer;
- masks must be worn permanently while being at the shooting venue in crowded places. Masks can be taken off only while eating;
- Physical distancing guidelines must be followed at all times.
- Disposable masks should be thrown out every day and reusable masks washed regularly;
- Upon display of any symptoms, cough or fever, members must seek medical attention asap then self-quarantine until obtaining a negative PCR.
