We wish to remind all our member federations that "Asian athletes will be able to earn Ranking Points in Asian Competitions only, which are Asian Games, Asian Youth Games, Asian Shooting Championships, Asian Rifle/Pistol Cup, Asian Shotgun Cup and Asian Grand Prix". Please refer to Asian Ranking Point System in the attachment.

Based on the foregoing, new Asian Ranking System will be implemented starting with 10th Asian Shotgun Championship in Almaty, Kazakhstan 2022 and 15th Asian Airgun Championship Daegu, Korea 2022.

We encourage all ASC federations to participate in Asian Competitions and benefit from new Asian Ranking System.

ASC ASIAN RANKING SYSTEM

1 The ASC Asian Ranking

- 1.1 The ASC Asian Ranking System ranks athletes according to their achievements in the ASC continental competitions in each individual men's and women's event of the Olympic program.
- 1.2 The athletes are ranked according to the amounts of ranking points they earned at the ASC Asian competitions.
- 1.3 The ASC Ranking starts from zero on 1st of January of each calendar year.
- 1.4 The earning of the ranking points is based on athletes' competition rank (place).
- 1.5 The ASC Asian Ranking serves to determine the best athletes participated in the ASC Asian competitions of the season.

2 The Ranking competitions

- 2.1 The Ranking ASC competitions are:
 - Asian Games
 - Asian Championships
 - Asian Cups
 Asian Grand Prix
- 2.2 The ranking points can be earned according to the following scales:

2.3 The ranking points should correspond to competition places taken by athletes, even if the number of participants is less than the number of ranking places foreseen for this category of competition.

3 <u>Distribution of ranking points</u>

- 3.1 Any athlete which is ineligible to participate in finals (article 7.6.2 of the ASC General Regulations, athletes registered for Ranking Points Only (RPO)) achieves score sufficient to qualify for the finals a regular competitor, he/she shall be awarded ranking points for the first unqualified competition place. If the number of finalists is eight (8), that competitor shall receive points for the ninth (9th) place. If there are two or more RPO athletes in this event who could be qualified for finals according to their scores, they shall all receive ranking points of the ninth (9th) competition place.
- 3.2 If the qualification for finals should be decided by shoot-off, all the participants of this shoot-off who was not qualified for the finals should be awarded ranking points of the ninth (9th) competition place.
