3. Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

Cartridge Controls (Shotgun)

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labelled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes.

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The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (There will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

The official Jury Members (Competition Jury, Jury of Appeal) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation to supervise the Asian Shotgun Championship.

Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will officiate at the competition.

4. Participation:

Each ASC Member Federation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for Ranking Points, according to the ISSF General Regulation.

4-3. Mixed Events:

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event.

4-4.Team events:

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes (Trap Team Men, Trap Team Women, Skeet Team Men, Skeet Team Women).


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5.Protests:

Any protest must be submitted a maximum **30 minutes** after the end of the round (Rule 9.13.7.2).

The protest fee is € 50 and appeal fee is € 100 -U.S Dollar equivalent is acceptable. The payment will be refunded; only if the protest is accepted. Protests and appeals should be in writing, using ISSF Protest Forms (available from the Organizers).

6. Entries

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must Register officially from his federation, All athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All shooters included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions. Late 'issue' of an ISSF ID will be considered as a 'late entry' under ISSF Rules.

NO DOUBLE STARTER IS ALLOWED

7.Late Entries:

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules. (Rule: 3.7.3).

Any Federation reducing the number of shooters/ or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organizing Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no shooter of that Federation may participate in the Championship. The Deadlines are as follows:

a. Final Entry Deadline - **20th January 2023**

b. Late Entry Deadline - 15th February 2023

c. From 17^{th} February 2023 onwards, no additional entries can be accepted.


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8. Entry Process:

Each ASC Federation entering the competition must submit the necessary forms (Annexes 1 - 9) and submit them before the following deadlines. All forms are available on the ISSF online Registration (http://entry.issf-sports.info) and ASC / KSSF websites.

 (Skeet Ranges Laporte Machines – Trap Ranges Laporte& Mattarelli Machines)


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10. Guns and Ammunition:

All information about shooter's Guns and Ammunition must be declared and sent not later than 5th JAN 2023 (Annex 8).

While in Kuwait, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armory at the shooting range. Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of Annex 8 (Details Form for Guns and Ammunition) while both entering and departing Kuwait.

The storage of guns and ammunition in hotels and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. Armory will be open to facilitate the arrival (as previously advised in Annex 4) of official teams until departure.

11.Doping Control:

Doping Control will operate in accordance with WADA/ISSF/ASC Rules and Regulations under the supervision of an ISSF/ASC appointed medical anti-doping officer.

15. Transportation/Airport:


Arrival Procedures

Participating teams will be met and facilitated on arrival at Kuwait International Airport. Teams will proceed to the visa office (as necessary) and then clear immigration and

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security controls. Participants will be transported to the Olympic Shooting Range to deposit their guns and then taken to their hotels. Transportation to and from hotels to the Range will be arranged by the Organizing Committee.

Please Note: to receive the copy of the visa on time applicants must send copy of passport by email, not later than **5**th **JAN 2023**.

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19. Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Programme for the Championships in accordance with ISSF Rules and Regulations.

20. Registration and Payments

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries! fees MUST be made to the Organizing Committee at the Registration Office at the shooting complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after all accounts have been fully paid and receipted by the Organizers.

21. Exchange Rates and Local Currency

During the competition, first aid and paramedical Provided.


