3. Rules and Regulations

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations. Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

Shotgun Equipment / Control

Equipment Control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment or/and clothing to the Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for shotguns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified, as per rules.

All skeet athletes must have an ISSF seal with serial number on the marker tapes of their shooting vests. Any shooting vests that do not have an ISSF seal on the marker tapes must be inspected by the Equipment Control/Shotgun Jury and the necessary seal must be affixed before the competition.

Cartridge Controls

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If the pellet weight of both cartridges is 24.50 g or less each, no further action will be taken. If the pellet weight of one (1) or both cartridges is more than 24.50g each, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be also tested. If the average pellet weight of the six (6) cartridges is more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ), in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 (a).

Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used. During Finals, all eight (8) finalists will be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals predesignated reporting area. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. If an athlete's cartridges or if an athlete does not report on time, then penalties will be imposed as per ISSF Rules. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes, and the boxes will be sealed. The boxes must be left under the supervision of the Equipment Control/Shotgun Jury Member at the reporting area. Once ammunition is placed in the box and sealed, only the Equipment Control/Shotgun Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. No additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals and will take the lower place, in the finalists ranking. The same procedures as in the individual events will be followed also for the Mixed Team events.

The official Jury Members (Competition Jury, Jury of Appeal) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation to supervise the Asian Shotgun Championship. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will officiate at the competition.

4. Participation:

Each ASC Member Federation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for Ranking Points, according to the ISSF / ASC General Regulation.

4-3. Mixed Events:

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event, but only one (1) of them can go (highest ranking team) to compete in the Final for the medals according to the ASC Rule 7.6.2, two bronze Medals will be awarded.

4-4. Team Events:

The three (3) athletes in the individual event registered to compete in the Final for the medals, their scores of the qualification rounds will be counted for the team events for their country, to be awarded the medals for first place, second place, and third place according to their ranking.

5.Protests Time Limit:

Any written protest (Protest Form P) must be submitted to a member of the Jury within ten (10) minutes after the end of the round in which the alleged incident occurred. The protest must be accompanied by a 50 EUR fee. If the protest is denied, the fee must be given to the Organizing Committee; if the protest is upheld the fee must be returned. (Rule 9.16.3.1).

Appeal Time Limit:

Such appeal must be submitted in written not later than ten (10) minutes after the Jury decision has been officially announced. The appeal must be accompanied by a 100 EUR fee. If the appeal is denied, the fee must be given to the Organizing Committee; if the appeal is upheld the fee must be returned.

The protest fee is € 50 and appeal fee is € 100 -U.S Dollar equivalent is acceptable. using ISSF Protest Forms (available in the Organizing Committee office or the Chief Jury).

6. Entries

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must Register officially from his federation, all athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number.

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All athletes included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions. Late 'issue' of an ISSF ID will be considered as a 'late entry' under ISSF Rules.

Quota Places for the 2024 Olympic Games Paris (FRA) will be awarded and ranking points will be recognized for Paris, as per ISSF Rules.

The table below specifies the number of quota places, per event that are available.

7.Late Entries:

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules. (Rule: 3.7.3).

Any Federation reducing the number of athletes / or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of athletes and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organizing Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no athletes of that Federation may participate in the Championship. The Deadlines are as follows:

a. Final Entry Deadline - 13 December 2023

b. Late Entry Deadline - 08 January 2024

c. From **09 January 2024** onwards, no additional entries can be accepted.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status (Asian Shotgun Championship athlete ↔ RPO only athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **09 January 2024** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **09 January 2024** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00 on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

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Maximum Entry

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Shotgun Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF / ASC Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

8. Entry Process:

- Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 10) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but ASC Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

- Preliminary Entries

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Shotgun Championship must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **12 NOV 2023**.

- Entry must be made by appropriate forms or by online ISSF registration system.
- Any entry accepted after the final entry deadline will incur a penalty of USD 50 per start, to be paid to the Organizing Committee by the defaulter federation.

NB: Visa Application Forms CANNOT be accepted via fax. Passport copies should be legible and sent electronically to the Organizing Committee.

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- Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the Asian Shotgun Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF/ASC Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range. Accreditations (for persons registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office of the Asian Shotgun Championship.Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

9. Shooting Ranges:

The Competitions will take place in the Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Olympic Range complex at Sulaibiya, Kuwait.

The Olympic Shotgun Ranges – 6 combined ranges
 (Skeet Ranges Laporte Machines – Trap Ranges Laporte Machines)

10. Guns and Ammunition:

All information about shooter's Guns and Ammunition must be declared and sent not later than 20 NOV 2023 (Annex 8).

While in Kuwait, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armory at the shooting range. Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of Annex 8 (Details Form for Guns and Ammunition) while both entering and departing Kuwait.

The storage of guns and ammunition in hotels and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. Armory will be open to facilitate the arrival (as previously advised in Annex 4) of official teams until departure.

11.Doping Control Tests:

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF/ASC/WADA Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations, and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan 2023 under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

Medals' ceremonies will take place daily as indicated in the provisional program. All teams must bring one copy of their national anthem (CD) and national flag (1 x 2 m) and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the accreditation process.

15. Transportation/Airport:

Arrival Procedures

Participating teams will be met and facilitated on arrival at Kuwait International Airport. Teams will proceed to the visa office (as necessary) and then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the Olympic Shooting Range to deposit their guns and then taken to their hotels.
