## 3. Rules and Regulations

The Asian Shooting Championship will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations. Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS / Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation to supervise the Asian Shooting Championship. Qualified Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

## **Shotgun Equipment**

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition, if available.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

## **Cartridge Controls**

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ), in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 (a).

During Finals all finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists and their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Finals (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals.

## **Colored Wads**

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete, uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

## **Equipment Control**

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Program of the competition.

## 4. Participation

## **Individual Events**

Each ASC Member Federation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for Ranking Points, according to the ISSF General Regulations and ASC General Regulations.

**Note only for Moving Target events:** In the 10m Moving Target, 50m Moving Target individual events each federation can enter an unlimited number of competitors. A minimum of eight (8) individuals in each men's event, or eight (8) individuals in each women's, must participate before individual medals are awarded.

#### **Juniors**

In the Asian Shooting Championship, Juniors each nation can enter a maximum of six (6) in individual events. Two (2) of those athletes must be the age of eighteen (18) years until 31st December in the year of the Championship, **OC will check "by hand" the requirement**. A maximum of three (3) athletes of one nation (the three top-ranked after Qualification) may proceed to the Final.

#### Youth

Youth are athletes who will be the age of eighteen (18) years or younger until 31st December in the year of the Championship concerned. **Entries will be managed by OC.** 

#### **Mixed Team Events**

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman per mixed team event, but only (1) of them can go (highest ranking team) to compete in the Final for the medals according to ASC General Regulations, article 7.6.2.

In the Mixed team competition, the top four (4) teams will be awarded According ASC General Regulations, article 15.5.2 as follows, after qualification to the medal matches.

1+2 for gold and silver medal match.

3+5 for bronze medal match one (1).

4+6 for bronze medal match two (2).

Two Bronze Medals will be awarded.

## **Team events**

ASC Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes. Three (3) Individual results will count as the Team result and the medals will be awarded.

**Note only for Moving Target events:** In the 10m Moving Target, 50m Moving Target team events each federation can enter an unlimited number of team. A minimum of three (3) teams in each men event, three (3) teams in each women event, must participate before team medals are awarded.

## **Maximum Entry**

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be accepted for each Asian Shooting Championship event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available ranges / firing points. **Entry process of Youth** participants must submit to the Organizing Committee directly.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF / ASC Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

## **ISSF ID Number**

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the Asian Shooting Championship.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Attention: Starting from 2025, all athletes, even with an official ISSF ID number already issued, must sign the actual "Athlete's Declaration" (Edition 2025) once again. Without renewed signature the athlete will not be allowed to participate in any ISSF Championship

# 5. Registration Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 - 8) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be done directly online by using the ISSF Online Registration System only. There are no separate Registration Form available, any entries received by mail will not be accepted.

## **Preliminary Entries**

ASC Member Federations entering the Asian Shooting Championship must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than 17 JUN 2025.

#### **Late Entries**

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is 12 AUG 2025.

**Important Note:** Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fees:

- a) Change of names / athletes within an event
- b) Change of Status (Asian Shooting Championship athlete  $\leftrightarrow$  RPO only athlete) within an event.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from 13 AUG 2025 onwards, may not participate.

## **Entry Confirmation upon arrival**

All Team Leaders of ASC Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

## **Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline**

From 13 AUG 2025 onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

## Cancellation

Any ASC Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (17 JUL 2025) must pay applicable cancellation fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

## **Entry Fee**

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The Entry Fee includes only one (1) round of PET (For the Unofficial Training rounds and for any extra rounds of PET, the cost must be paid to the OC).

## **Payment of Entry Fees**

All payments **MUST BE** cash in Euro / US Dollars only to the Organizing Committee upon arrival at the shooting complex. Payment using either credit or debit cards or travelers or bank cheques **will NOT be accepted**. Upon request, invoice can be sent for payment through bank transfer 2 weeks before Official Arrival day. **Any charge**, deducted by bank shall be collected from the federation making payment through bank transfer.

Federations are requested to clearly assign payment to Organizing Committee in order to afford credit to the federation.

## **Accreditation Process**

All delegation members involved in the Asian Shooting Championship (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media representatives) must have accreditations that clearly identify its holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for delegation members registered before the Late Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Asian Shooting Championship Accreditation Office.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after the payment of the entry fees.

# 9. Travel and Transportation

#### Travel - Arrival

All participating federations are encouraged to book flights for two destinations: Nursultan Nazarbayev International Airport (Astana-NQZ), Almaty International Airport (Almaty-ALA) and Shymkent International Airport (Shymkent-CIT). There will be **NO ASSISTANCE** at customs and immigration for participants arriving at other airports.

## Airport pick up - Transportation to the Official Hotels (and back for departure)

All delegates will be received at a welcome desk at the airport by the OC at the Shymkent airport and necessary arrangements will be made for the transfers to the hotels.

Service duration: from the airport it would take about 40/50 minutes to reach the hotels.

## **Local Transportation – Shuttle Service**

Local transportation between the official hotels and the shooting range will be arranged by the Organizing Committee during training and competition days only (17 - 29 AUG 2025).

Distance from the hotels to the ranges is approximately 10 to 15 kilometers and takes 25 to 30 minutes to reach there.

The bus schedules for transportation from the hotels to the ranges and back will be available at the Info Centre and in the official hotels.

# 10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

## **Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place starting from 17 AUG 2025 at the shooting range.

Each participating ASC Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Asian Shooting Championship. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

## Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

The Arms and Ammunition will be stored at the Range in the armory and will not be allowed to be taken out of the shooting range premises at any time. Upon arrival at Almaty International Airport, after checking through customs, all firearms will be transported by the Organizing Committee directly to the Asanov Shooting Club. The Arms and Ammunition will be stored at the Range in the armory and will be not allowed to taken out of the shooting range premises at any time as per the Firearm (Weapon) laws of Kazakhstan.
