Dear Friends,

The Asian Shooting Confederation (ASC) would like to inform its member federations that the 13th Asian Youth Training Camp will now be organized only in **Air Pistol** discipline from **11-20 Aug 2025** in **Shymkent**, Kazakhstan. This will provide participating youth/junior athletes with the opportunity to train in preparation for the 16th Asian Shooting Championship (all events) in Shymkent and participate in the 10m Air Pistol event for juniors or youth accordingly.

Please refer to the following conditions and general requirements:

1. The hotel accommodation, local transportation, meals and ammunition expenses for **one shooter and one coach** from each member federation will be covered by the Kazakhstan Sports Shooting Federation.
2. Participants will be responsible for the cost and booking of their own air tickets.
3. The total number of participants will be limited to 30 only on a first-come first-served basis, and registration will be closed upon reaching this number.
4. Any additional athletes may be accommodated, provided they cover all their expenses.

The Asian Youth Training Camps will include the following:

1. Firearm safety workshop for shooters.
2. Practical training, theoretical and technical courses for shooters and coaches.
3. Doping workshop, physical training, psychology and sports nutrition courses for shooters.
